

## Anaesthesia Fellowships

Vacancies exist for Anaesthetic Fellows at Capital and Coast District Health Board (Wellington and Keneperu Hospitals) for the 2012 contractual year. Wellington Hospital is the newest of New Zealand's large tertiary teaching institutions; the centre of an active anaesthesia educational program with high pass rates in Part 1 and 2 examinations for FANZCA and site of a high-fidelity patient simulation centre.
