



Anaesthetic Fellowships Dec 2011 – Dec 2012
Counties Manukau District Health Board, Auckland, New Zealand

Applications are invited for **two** fellowships in anaesthesia which offer an exciting opportunity to join a large friendly department providing tertiary level health care services.

Fellows will provide anaesthesia for adult, paediatric and obstetric services across 2 sites in Auckland; at Middlemore Hospital an 860-bed hospital with 11 ORs, and Manukau Surgical Centre, a 10 OR elective surgical unit. With the exception of cardiac and neurosurgery, all major surgical specialties are on site and successful applicants will work within a multi-cultural community with a diverse range of health needs.

The two fellowships are general duty posts but an interest in burns anaesthesia or education/simulation would be advantageous for successful applicants.

The department has introduced a regular educational programme specifically for fellows, focussing on professional attributes and non clinical skills. Successful applicants would also be expected to participate in audit, teaching, research and other departmental activities.

Preferences will be given to candidates with fellowship, and ANZCA trainees post-ATY2 who have completed their formal project. Weekend and evening work can be expected and a small number of night shifts may also be required. Registration with the New Zealand Medical Council is essential.
